## Invitation to attend the DHIS 2 Academy East Africa 2013 Advanced Level, Entebbe, June 4-13 2013

Health Information Systems Program (HISP-EA) together with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) - Uganda and the University of Oslo, are pleased to announce the “DHIS 2 Academy East Africa 2013 - Advanced Level” to be held at the [Imperial Botanical Beach Hotel](#), Entebbe, Uganda, June 4-13 2013.

This year the DHIS 2 Academy East Africa is split into two levels; basic and advanced. The Academy in Entebbe in June will be the advanced level, and a basic level Academy will be organised in November/December 2013. The advanced level is a technical training meant for experienced DHIS 2 implementers or system administrators that have already attended the DHIS 2 Academy before and are ready to learn more advanced features and functionality of the DHIS 2 software.

Due to the overall capacity of the training we will have to limit the invitations to about 2-3 people per country, but the exact numbers will of course depend on the overall interest. We welcome DHIS 2 implementers from all organisational forms, whether government, NGOs, private sector, independent consultants or others. Countries from Eastern and Southeastern Africa are welcome to attend.

Experienced DHIS 2 trainers will share the latest features and customisation approaches and help you to make your DHIS 2 implementation a success. Training topics will include; database manipulations and queries, data migration, advanced form design, advanced report design, GIS setup, DHIS Tracker, mobile clients, Web-API and integration, new web pivot tool, new sharing/access control system, and more. A practical training programme will make sure the trainers and participants can also sit together and improve the participants’ DHIS 2 databases. This workshop will be a great opportunity for you to share and discuss your DHIS 2 implementation experiences with other implementers from the region and to gain new insight into important implementation topics. Members of the DHIS 2 development team will be present and we encourage all participants to come with detailed feedback to the developers on existing functionality as well as requests for future releases. Only with the help from the implementers and users, the DHIS 2 can move forward in the right direction.

The academy training fee is 650 USD, including 10 days of lunch and tea breaks from June 4 to 13. Please register here: <http://dhis2.org/entebbe2013-reg> . The organisers will evaluate your qualifications and the country quotas and get back to you as soon as possible. After receiving confirmation from the organisers, please proceed with the training fee payment. Bank details in the annex. Remember to include name and organisation of the participant in the payment information. Only after receiving the payment your registration is considered complete.

This year the participants will have to organise their own accommodation. The venue offers a group discount of B&B for about 85 USD per night. Feel free to contact us for recommendations in other price ranges.
