HISP Vietnam and University of Oslo are pleased to announce two “DHIS 2 Academy Asia 2016” to be held at the New World Saigon Hotel, Ho Chi Minh City, Viet Nam from June 22-1st July 2016.

1. DHIS2 fundamental Academy:

Objective: The four-day fundamental academy is towards guiding participants in design and establishing routine information system for their health program with best practices from global experiences.

Topics:

- i) Design principles and best practices for all major aspects of DHIS 2 database design/set-up
- ii) Design and set-up of data quality tools such as validation and surveillance rules.
- iii) Use and administration of analysis tools such as data visualiser, pivot tables and GIS
- iv) Use of DHIS 2 user group/sharing to organize health program access keeping view on centralized setup. (E.G: Access related to data from Malaria, TB, HIV, MCH to respective health program owner plus share data across program with access rights)
- v) Best practice and common problem/challenges in implementation and maintenance of DHIS2

Training Cost: The four-day academy fee is 470 USD including training materials, lunch, two tea breaks and one trainer-participant dinner

2. DHIS2 tracker Academy:

Objective: The five-day tracker academy will be geared towards design and development of event-based and individual based program to meet the emerging needs of **disease surveillance** in South-East Asia region.

Topics:

- i) Design principle and best practices around creation and implementation of event based program for disease surveillance such as malaria, dengue and others
- ii) Design principle and best practices around creation and implementation of tracker



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- based program for tracking individual throughout their health program such as TB, Malaria elimination program, Mother and Child program.
- iii) Creation of surveillance alerts to health program officers and health providers
 - iv) Use of event and individual analytics tools
 - v) Best practice and common problem/challenges in integrating systems (event/individual to aggregate system, different health programs, other systems).

Training Cost: The five-day academy fee is 700 USD including training materials, five lunch, two tea breaks per day and two trainer-participant dinner

Pre-Request: DHIS 2 tracker academy requires participant with knowledge and working understanding of DHIS 2 and have completed DHIS 2 Fundamental Academy.

We would like to invite 4 to 7 people from each country / organization in Asia to join these two academies. DHIS 2 experts from global and the region will share the latest features and development, best practices around the globe to help you to make your DHIS 2 implementation a success in your country and/or across your organization. A practical training programme will make sure the trainers and participants can work together on your own databases and issues and guide you to solve emerging issue.
